



ROSEMONT 11TH ANNUAL WINE & ART FESTIVAL

The eleventh annual Rosemont Wine and Art Festival will be held on the grounds of ROSEMONT VINEYARDS, located at 1050 Blackridge Road, LaCrosse, VA on Saturday, June 15, from 10am – 5pm. If you wish to participate in this fun-filled day, and promote your work in this beautiful setting, please return the application below by **March 30th**.

This is our biggest event of the year, drawing more than 2,000 art enthusiasts and while we are constantly working to improve each year, we can only do that with support from great artists! Rosemont Wine and Art Festival is a **juried Fine Art Show with a very limited number of booth spaces available**. All work must be original handmade designs (no kits, molded or “purchased and enhanced” products, i.e. manufactured glassware, wood, metal products embellished with paint). All work must be original and in the Fine Art categories. Please note that no commercial products will be accepted!

SHOW GUIDELINES:

The entry fee for the show is \$60.00 for a 12x12 space. Your fee is due immediately upon acceptance, by May 6th. We cannot guarantee your space if we do not receive your fee by that date. Your fee will NOT be returned if you cancel or do not attend the show.

Artists must supply their own equipment, tables, tents, etc needed for display in the 12x12 space. No electrical outlets are available. *Please note that only one space will be available for each artist this year due to space constraints and only one artist is permitted per space.* Tent sharing is not permitted.

Artists must be setup and ready to sell by 9:30 a.m. You may setup your tent on Friday, June 14th prior to 6:00p.m. The winery does not take responsibility for any damages. The winery will be open until 6:00 p.m. Food and drink will be available from vendors at the festival, and an Artist Lounge will be available for all artists to use throughout the day.

All displays should be attractive, neat, inviting, and safe. The overall appearance and quality of your display should be consistent with other outdoor exhibitions at major shows. Be sure that all displays are secured and not subject to being blown down. All displays will be located outside on the winery grounds. No indoor display area is available. When packing up, please be sure all trash, etc from your space is picked up and disposed of properly.

Only the media type by the artist that was juried in the show may be sold. (Example: if you submit your application for birdhouses, you may not show and sell wine glasses.)

Vendors are responsible for their own crafts and sales. Booths should not be left unattended. If you would like to take credit cards from attendees and do not have the ability to do so, you can fill out an application through the Winery to offer that service.
